If you do not have Liquitex<sup>®</sup> paint, you may match the colors with other acrylic paint lines. However, Liquitex Basics<sup>®</sup> are recommended to achieve the results featured in this book. Occasionally, you can mix Liquitex<sup>®</sup> Super Heavy Gel or Liquitex<sup>®</sup> Modeling Paste into your acrylic paints to create a textured "oil-like" appearance to your paintings.

This lesson can be completed on heavy cardstock paper, canvas board, or stretched canvas.

## This lesson recommends the following Liquitex<sup>®</sup> acrylic paint:

- Cadmium Red Medium Hue
- Cadmium Yellow Deep
- Cerulean Blue
- Cobalt Blue
- Dioxazine Purple
- Magenta
- Navy
- Phthalocyanine Blue
- Primary Yellow
- Titanium White
- Ultramarine
- Viridian

If oil paints are preferred, you can match these acrylic colors to oil colors. Canvas should be used with oil paints.
